FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS SHEET

GARDENS IV WATERSIDE VILLAGE ASSOCIATION, INC.

As of January 1, 2023

- Q. What are my voting rights in the condominium association?
- A. A unit owner is entitled to cast one vote for each unit owned in the condominium. There are 36 units.
- Q. What restrictions exist in the condominium documents on my right to use my unit?
- A. The use is restricted to a single family residential use. The Association has a detailed set of official documents and bylaws for unit owners.
- Q. What restrictions exist in the condominium documents on the leasing of my unit?
- A. With approval of the Board of Directors, there is a minimum ninety (90) day rental period.
- Q. How much are my assessments to the condominium association for my unit type and when are they due?
- A. Nine Hundred Thirty-five dollars (\$1,175.00) per quarter per each unit. Assessments are due on the first day of each month of the quarter.
- Q. Do I have to be a member in any other association? If so, what is the name of the association and what are my voting rights in this association? Also, how much are my assessments?
- A. Gardens IV at Waterside is also a member of the Waterside Community Association. Assessments are included in the maintenance fees for Gardens IV.
- Q. Am I required to pay rent or land use fees for recreational or other commonly used facilities? If so, how much am I obligated to pay annually?
- A. Gardens IV at Waterside Association pays fees to the Waterside Community Association for the use of the recreational facilities for its unit owners.
- Q. Is the condominium association or other mandatory membership association involved in any court cases in which it may face liability in excess of \$100,000? If so, identify each such case.
